In this workshop, we will experience Lily Yeh's methodology of building community through self-expression, creative action, and finding communal voices. We will learn how she focuses on creating public art -- mosaics and murals -- with community members as a form of healing and empowerment. This session will be hands-on, experimental, and participatory.

**Lily Yeh** is a remarkable individual who helps others use the arts as a medium for personal and social transformation. Fueled by a belief that art is a human right and that artists can create a foundation for profound social change, she works with a school for migrant children outside of Beijing, genocide survivors in Rwanda, neighborhoods in north Philadelphia, and impoverished communities all over the world.
